

4th Grade Supply List - Mrs. Falk

1 Large, sturdy backpack. (Students will have 4 large textbooks and a binder this year)

Water Bottle with Name on it

Headphones or Earbuds to be used in Computer Class (To be left at School)

4 **LARGE** stretch book covers

Flash drive- **LABEL WITH NAME**

Ruler with inches and centimeters/millimeters

3-4 packages wide ruled line paper

#2 pencils sharpened (**several packs – will need some for both classrooms and for home**)

1 small box colored pencils

1 small box crayons

1 box markers (optional)

Small glue bottle

Pink Eraser (large)

Red pens

2 permanent markers

Personal hand held pencil sharpener (to fit in desk and zippered pouch)

Scissors (**Fiskars Brand Work Best**)

4 pocket folders with 3 holes to fit in a binder (**NO BRADS/ no metal fasteners**)

2 spiral notebooks (one for science and one for Florida history)

1 ½ inch sturdy binder **with clear outside pockets on front and back** (any color)

Large sturdy zippered pouch to keep supplies in (and to take back and forth to both classrooms)

2 or more containers Clorox wipes

1-2 bottles hand sanitizer (at least 62% alcohol based to be effective)

3 boxes tissues

1 roll of paper towels

1 box zippered baggies (**girls** bring sandwich size; **boys** bring quart or gallon size)

Additional/OPTIONAL items to donate to the classroom (not required, but appreciated! ☺)

Extra pencils, art supplies, gently used board games

Extra Clorox wipes or Lysol spray (to keep germs at bay!)

Reams of copy paper (preferably white, but will use anything you bring ☺)

Expo markers for white boards

Large bottle (gallon size) Elmer's glue for science

Fabric Band-Aids, no latex please

Prepackaged individual sized snacks to keep on hand in case a classmate forgets to bring theirs.

Tip: When choosing a zippered pouch for supplies, remember that students will keep their pencils, crayons, glue, eraser, pens, markers, pencil sharpeners and flash drives in their pouches. Make sure these items will fit in securely when zipped up – students will be carrying these pouches to both classrooms during the day.
