

5th Grade Supply List – Mrs. Heslin

1 Large sturdy backpack (Students will have 4 large textbooks and a binder this year)

Water Bottle with name on it

Headphones or Earbuds for Computer Class (To be left at school)

4 **LARGE** stretch book covers

1 regular size stretch book cover

Flash drive- **LABEL WITH NAME** (may use same one from previous year)

24 #2 pencils (for use in both classrooms and at home)

2 - 3 packages of wide ruled paper

Ruler with inches, centimeters and millimeters (for math class)

1 box colored pencils

1 box markers and/or crayons

1 large pink eraser

1 large glue stick or small bottle of glue

1 package red pens (for use in both classrooms)

2 permanent markers

Scissors (**Fiskars Brand Work Best**)

2 folders with 2 pockets and brads (for writing and Bible)

2 spiral notebooks (one for social studies and one for science)

1 composition notebook

4 pocket folders with 3 holes to fit in a binder (**NO BRADS/ no metal fasteners**)

1 ½ inch sturdy 3-ring binder **with CLEAR OUTSIDE pockets on front AND back**

Large sturdy zippered pouch to keep supplies in (and to take back and forth to both classrooms)

2 or more containers Clorox wipes

1-2 bottles hand sanitizer (at least 62% alcohol based to be effective)

2-3 boxes tissues

Tip: When choosing a zippered pouch for supplies, remember that students will keep their pencils, crayons, glue, eraser, pens, markers, pencil sharpeners and flash drives in their pouches. Make sure these items will fit in securely when zipped up – students will be carrying these pouches to both classrooms during the day.

Additional/OPTIONAL items to donate to the classroom (not required but appreciated 😊)

Extra Clorox wipes or Lysol spray (to keep germs at bay!)

Ream of copy paper or cardstock

Expo markers for white boards

Fabric Band-Aids, no latex please

Zippered baggies – any size

Prepackaged individual sized snacks* to keep on hand in case a classmate forgets to bring theirs.
