

ACA ELEMENTARY SUMMER MATH PRACTICE PROGRAM

Grades 2 – 5

Upcoming second, third, fourth and fifth graders may participate in the Summer Math Practice Program. This program is simply practicing grade appropriate facts over the summer. This consists of:

- Upcoming second graders – basic addition and subtraction facts
- Upcoming third graders – basic addition, subtraction & multiplication facts
- Upcoming fourth graders – basic multiplication facts
- Upcoming fifth graders – basic division facts

These basic facts sheets are available to you on **aucilla.org**. Please make as many copies as you need. Students who complete 10 of these fact sheets, each signed by a parent, will receive 10 extra credit points added to a math test during the first nine week grading period. Students who complete 20 of these fact sheets, also signed by a parent, will receive 20 extra credit points added to a math test during the first nine week grading period.

PLEASE NOTE: These fact sheets are the only acceptable sheets which will be given credit. Also, students must answer these sheets correctly! They are checked before points are awarded.

We are not encouraging students to learn new concepts in the summer; we are simply trying to help students retain what has been taught and learned in the previous grade.

All sheets must be turned into the upcoming grade teacher by Tuesday, August 9, 2022; none will be accepted after this date!

We encourage you to have your child complete these grade appropriate sheets. We also suggest you time students as they complete these; six minutes is appropriate per hundred facts.

This review will definitely help students as they begin a new year of study in Math!
