

Mrs. Fletcher's 5th Grade Supply List

1 8x10 black and white photo of your child for a classroom gallery wall

1 Large sturdy backpack (Students will have 4 large textbooks and a binder this year)

Water Bottle with name on it

Headphones or Earbuds for Computer Class (To be left at school)

4 **LARGE** stretch book covers

1 regular size stretch book cover

Flash drive- **LABEL WITH NAME** (may use same one from previous year)

2 boxes of #2 pencils (for use in both classrooms and at home/Ticonderoga preferred)

4 packages of wide ruled paper

Ruler with inches, centimeters and millimeters (for math class)

1 box colored pencils

1 box markers

1 box of crayons

4 large pink erasers

4 large glue sticks

1 pack of red gel pens (for use in both classrooms)

2 black permanent markers

Scissors (**Fiskars Brand Work Best**)

4 folders with 2 pockets and brads (1 blue folder, 1 green, other 2 folders can be student choice)

2 large spiral notebooks (1 blue and 1 green-the larger style with the tabs would be awesome)

1 single subject spiral notebook (any style they prefer)

2 composition notebooks

4 pocket folders with 3 holes to fit in a binder (**NO BRADS/ no metal fasteners /1 blue, 1 green, other 2 are student choice**)

1 **½ inch** sturdy 3-ring binder **with CLEAR OUTSIDE pockets on front AND back**

Large sturdy **zippered pouch to keep supplies in (and to take back and forth to both classrooms)

4 or more containers Clorox wipes

1 can of Lysol spray

1 box of gallon Ziploc bags

1 pack of microwave safe plates

1 box of plastic spoons

2 large bottles of hand sanitizer (at least 62% alcohol based to be effective)

4 boxes tissues

Additional/OPTIONAL items to donate to the classroom (not required but appreciated ☺)

Extra Clorox wipes or Lysol spray (to keep germs at bay!)

Ream of copy paper cardstock

Expo markers for white boards

1 box of Band-Aids

Zippered baggies – any size

Prepackaged individual sized snacks* to keep on hand in case a classmate forgets to bring theirs.

Box of magic erasers

Individually wrapped candy for treat jar

Tip: When choosing a zippered pouch for supplies, remember that students will keep their pencils, crayons, glue, eraser, pens, markers, and flash drives in their pouches. Make sure these items will fit in securely when zipped up – students will be carrying these pouches to both classrooms during the day.
