

# K-5 SUPPLY LIST

1. Box of **8 basic color**, regular size crayons (You may buy larger box but only send the 8 basic colors. Do not send jumbo or large size crayons) \*\*
2. Elmer's School Glue (**4 oz. size**) -- **NO PASTE**
3. 4 - small Elmer's glue sticks\*\*
4. 1- pair scissors (**Fiskars brand** work best)
5. 1 - **sturdy** folder with pockets (**NO BRADS**) - (like the Mead Five Star Paper folder)
6. 1- **STURDY, VINYL** folder **WITH BRADS AND POCKETS**
7. 1 - 3-ring, clear/see-through pencil pouch with a zipper to be placed in vinyl folder
8. 1 - small (no larger than 8x10) white board (Dollar Tree has great ones)
9. 6 - dry erase markers, any color
10. 1 - box washable classic color markers (not skinny)
11. 1 - 8 basic color washable watercolor set
12. 1 - large container disinfectant wipes (example: Clorox, Lysol, Store Brand)
13. 1 - package of paper plates (no Styrofoam, please)
14. 4 pink rectangular erasers
15. Large backpack
16. **Leak-proof, spill-proof Water Bottle with name on it**

## **BOYS:**

- 1 - large bottle of hand sanitizer
- 1 - container of baby wipes

## **GIRLS:**

- 1 - roll of paper towels
- 1 - box of spoons

## **WISH LIST ITEMS TO DONATE:**

Tissues

- 1 - ream of copy paper
- 1- bag of small size candy to use as rewards, such as Skittles, M&Ms, Gummy Bears, Smarties, etc.
- 1 - package of white cardstock
- 1 - package of colored cardstock
- 1-box of plastic forks
- Regular size playdough
- Reward stickers (Dollar Tree has lots in their school section)
